Robert Castle, artistic director of the International Theatre New York, will be back in Berlin this summer.

During 2 weeks Robert Castle, a seasoned actor/director and long-time coach, will run one of his internationally successful 'Method Acting' workshops. The uniqueness of his method is an evolution of 'Method Acting'.

More than just the creation of the character, the aim became the creation of the soul of the character through a series of new exercises, including 'Imagined Experience and Image Work'. The results have been transformational. Already competent Method actors have enthusiastically endorsed this evolution of the 'Method Technique'.

A daily 6-8 hours training of relaxation, sense memory exercises, and scene/monologue work will develop your artistic instrument over a long period of time.

Robert Castle has trained many prominent actors, and has worked as an actor or director with modern luminaries such as Sean Penn, Michelle Pfeiffer, Jeff Goldblum, George Segal, Jane Fonda, Angie Dickenson, and many others.

Each actor will be working on a scene and a monologue, always from great writers. We provide the scripts, and pair the actor with a scene partner before the workshop starts. The actors have the opportunity of getting on stage several times with their scenes during the course of the workshop. The scenes are worked on experientially. For this reason, text analysis is not done as a sit-down academic exercise, but rather as an ongoing discovery of the life of the character and the world of the play or film.

Whether you're an actor, dancer, singer, writer, or director, this workshop will reshape the way you approach your art and you are welcome in a safe, non-competitive, yet challenging environment. There is the possibility of passive participation (viewing) as well.
